PALLET JACK NARROW AISLE

CONTESTANT# _____

PROCEDURE:

The operator will enter the aisle with a loaded pallet and proceed to the end of the aisle. The operator will set the pallet as close to the back barrier as possible without hitting it. The operator will then back up clearing the forks from the pallet. This will be the indication that the judge can take a measurement. The judge will signal the contestant that the measurement is complete. The operator will then move forward, pick up the pallet and back out of the aisle and return the start position.

NOTE: The aisle will be 3 inches wider than the widest part of the pallet jack

SCORING:

1 to 3 inches	100 points
4 to 6 inches	90 points
7 to 9 inches	80 points
10 to 12 inches	70 points
Over 12 inches	50 points
Hitting back barrier	-50 points

The operator will attempt to negotiate the barricades (without a load) in one motion, first going forward and then in reverse.

Each pull-up after starting thru the barricades	- 20 points
